

1. POLICIES

- 1.1 A Private Non-Sale Competition licence authorizes:
- a) the licensee to transport homemade wine, cider or beer to and from the licensed premises at which the competition specified in the licence will take place.
 - b) the licensee to display the homemade wine, cider or beer in the licensed premises during the period of time specified in the licence, and
 - c) the people judging and participating in the competition to taste the homemade wine, cider or beer in the licensed premises.
- 1.2 A Private Non-Sale Competition licence will only be issued by the AGLC.
- 1.3 The licensee must have the legal right to occupy and control the licensed area for the duration of the event (ownership, rental agreement, contract).
- 1.4 The licensee is responsible for ensuring compliance with all legislation, policies and requirements governing the consumption of liquor.
- 1.5 A Private Non-Sale Competition licensee must comply with the Special Event Licence General Policies and Guidelines.
- 1.6 The application for a Competition Special Event Licence must include the following:
- a) the number of days the display and/or competition will be held;
 - b) the hours of the display or competition; and
 - c) the specific location where the display or competition will be held.
- 1.7 The fee for a Competition Special Event licence is \$25.00.
- 1.8 The sale of liquor is prohibited under a Special Event Private Non-Sale Competition licence.
