As with any special event, the AGLC asks the organizer to submit an application outlining their vision for the event. Some music events choose site-wide licensing. This means liquor consumption is not restricted to a specific area, like a beer garden. While it's entirely up to the organizers to choose how they manage their events, the AGLC works with them to determine what would work best and what needs to be done to ensure compliance with policies.

In fact, we have issued several site wide licences over the last few years in both Edmonton and Calgary.
