

# Personal importation of liquor from other provinces

## **Can I buy liquor products from other provinces in Alberta?**

Yes. Alberta's privatized liquor model ensures that a wide variety of liquor products are available to Albertans right here in the province.

Visit [LiquorConnect.com](http://LiquorConnect.com) to see if the product is already available in Alberta, which stores it is available at, including those closest to you. [LiquorConnect.com](http://LiquorConnect.com) also contains information on how to go about getting the product here through a local retailer or liquor agent.

## **Can I bring liquor products back with me from a holiday in another province?**

Adult Albertans who travel to other provinces can bring home liquor of any kind for personal consumption. There are no limits on quantity or frequency as long as the liquor accompanies the individual and is for the individual's personal use.

## **I've heard there are many great wines produced in Canada. How can I get these wines here in Alberta?**

Alberta's privatized liquor model ensures that a wide variety of liquor products, including many fine Canadian wines, are available to Albertans right here in the province. In fact, many wines from B.C., Ontario, Manitoba and Nova Scotia for example are already available for sale in Alberta, in addition to Alberta's own fruit wine and mead.

If you are looking for liquor products that may not be available in your local liquor store, here are the options on how to go about getting these products:

1. Search for the product on [LiquorConnect.com](http://LiquorConnect.com). Thousands of liquor products are registered for sale in Alberta but may not be stocked by all private liquor stores. [LiquorConnect.com](http://LiquorConnect.com) shows which products are available, and at which stores.
2. Speak with staff or management at your local liquor store. Products that are not on the shelves may be brought in at customer request.
3. If products are not currently available in Alberta, liquor stores are able to work with registered liquor agencies in order to have them brought in.
4. You can also contact agencies directly by searching for similar products at [LiquorConnect.com](http://LiquorConnect.com). View agency details for similar products and contact the agency to request the product be brought into Alberta for you.
5. Orders may be taken online by liquor stores that choose to provide this service. Alberta liquor stores are authorized to sell and deliver liquor to adults in accordance with provincial liquor laws.

## **Do I have an option of purchasing wines directly from a winery in B.C. for example?**

If you are travelling to another province, yes, you may purchase wine from a local winery and bring it home. There is no limit on how much you may purchase.

However, the wine must be for personal consumption and brought back to Alberta with you.
