JOB SUMMARY

AGLC is looking for dynamic professionals to join its growing Information Technology Division. Would you like to work in an environment that offers a change of pace, diversity, and work life balance? Are you looking for an organization that will value your experience and allow you to contribute to its innovation and modernization agenda? Then you have come to the right place!

In this position you will be an integral part of AGLC's Enterprise Integration Centre for Enablement (C4E) team which is responsible for the development and operation of all the application integration initiatives in the AGLC, this includes application integration with internal AGLC systems as well as the integration between the ALGC systems and external vendors.

In this position you will be expected to be able to:

- Identify the solution integration requirements and specifications across multiple systems.
- Develop and document the integration APIs based on the AGLC development standards.
- Help in designing, documenting and implementing the solution integration architecture.
- · Help in designing, documenting, and implementing a security scheme to authorize and encrypt the APIs traffic using the best practices.
- Leverage the capabilities of the enterprise service bus to accomplish the development integration tasks.
- Build unit tests as well as integration tests for the integration APIs.
- Build API definitions and specs using RAML or any other compatible tool.
- Configure the CI (continues integration) environments.
- Provide the technical support when the project(s) goes live.
- Provide code reviews and make sure the code follows all current and applicable standards.
- · Identify issues and provide written and verbal recommendation on them to the team leader.
- Perform QA reviews of deliverables.
- · Provide mentoring for junior staff.
- Provide after-hours support for production systems when needed.
- Work with the AGLC integration team and share the knowledge and experience.

- A Technical Computer Systems Technology diploma from a recognized institution (e.g. NAIT) or related university
- A minimum of 5 years related experience, specifically in enterprise application integration
