

Community Events

In accordance with the Charitable Gaming Policies Handbook (CGPH) 4.3.6 and 4.4.4 gaming proceeds may be used for eligible community events that are open to the public.

Gaming proceeds must not be used to support commercial or for-profit activities.

- Groups using less than \$100,000 in gaming proceeds do not require prior AGLC approval.
- Groups using \$100,000 or more in gaming proceeds must request prior AGLC approval. See ([form 5457](#))

Community event expenses may include:

- Venue or facility rental
- Rental or purchase of equipment, supplies, furnishings, uniforms, costumes, or vehicles
- Security
- Event advertising and promotion
- Wages/salaries (see CGPH 4.4.27)
- Entertainment
- Fireworks
- Floats
- Clean-up
- Municipal fees, excluding items such as liquor licence fees and vendor permits
- Food and non-alcoholic beverages
