

Gaming proceeds may be used to purchase uniforms/costumes if they are essential to the delivery of the licensed group's charitable programs. Charitable Gaming Policies Handbook 5.10

Approved use of gaming proceeds appear on the group's current Use of Proceeds (UOP) list. If items do not appear on the UOP list, a request must be submitted to AGLC for prior approval. A group may view its current UOP list via the Online Services portal at aglc.ca with an active internet account.

Eligible items may include:

- Volunteer shirts/pinnies
- Sports uniforms for competitive or practice play (warm up suits and team jackets not eligible)
- Dance costumes
- Drama costumes

The licensed group must develop a written policy that is available to AGLC upon request. The policy must include the following criteria:

- Ownership of the item is to remain with the licensed group. Items of a personal, social, or promotional nature are not eligible.
- Items must be required for competitive play, practice, or artistic performances and must include a distinctive logo or markings. Items cannot be personalized nor be of a personal nature (e.g. swimsuits, socks, etc.)
- Items are to be used by athletes/performers during the normal competitive/performance season and must be returned to the licensed group at the end of the season.
- Items cannot be worn/used for activities that are not directly related to games, practices or performances.
